



## Societies Federation members Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is to be adhered to in conjunction with the UCSU Constitution, By-Laws and Equality and Diversity Policy.

All SU Societies Federation members must read, agree to and abide by this code of conduct and be aware of the repercussions.

1. Represent and uphold the values associated with SU Societies and the SU Societies Federation
2. Recognise the rights of all members to be treated as individuals and champion the rights of every individual to participate in Societies
3. Not use abusive language directed towards members, Society Officials, University staff, guest speakers/performers or SU staff
4. Not use violent or aggressive behaviour whilst representing SU Societies in activities, events meetings or general Society activities on or off campus.
5. Attend relevant workshops and training sessions held by SU Societies or the Societies Federation at the start of the academic year and in relation to UCSU policies
6. Abide by the Students Union's Equality and Diversity Policy and not discriminate against any members or potential members on the base of their age, disability, care responsibilities, cultural origin, employment status, gender reassignment, marriage and civil partnership, political beliefs, pregnancy or maternity, religion or belief, sex, sexual orientation, social class, trade union activity, unrelated criminal convictions, or any other relevant distinction
7. Abide by the University and the Students' Union's Social media policies and act responsibly in the presentation of their-selves and the Society thereon.

Failure to adhere to the SU Societies Code of Conduct may result in the suspension or termination of their membership with immediate effect.
