Member Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is to be adhered to in conjunction with the UCSU Constitution, By-Laws and Equality and Diversity Policy. All SU Sport Federation members must read and abide by this code of conduct and be aware of the repercussions of any breach.

All members of the SU Sports Federation will:

1. Represent and uphold the values associated with SU Sports and the SU Sports Federation
2. Recognise the rights of all to be treated as individuals and champion the rights of every individual to participate in sport
3. Not use abusive or inappropriate language towards opponents, officials, coaching staff, team mates or SU staff
4. Not use violent or aggressive behaviour whilst representing SU Sport in training, competition or general club activities on or off campus
5. Attend relevant workshops and training sessions held by SU Sports and/or the Sports Federation at the start of the academic year and in relation to UCSU policies
6. Support and abide by to the Sports Charter (which tackles homophobia, bi-phobia and trans-phobia in sport)
7. Abide by the Students Union's Equality and Diversity Policy and not discriminate against any members or potential members on the base of their: age, disability, care responsibilities, cultural origin, employment status, gender reassignment, marriage and civil partnership, political beliefs, pregnancy or maternity, religion or belief, sex, sexual orientation, social class, trade union activity, unrelated criminal convictions, and/or any other relevant distinction
8. Abide by the University and the Students' Union's Social media policies and act responsibly in the presentation of their-selves and the Club thereon

Failure to adhere to the SU Sports Federation member code of conduct may result in action being brought against you in line with the Sports Federation disciplinary procedures.
